

PAY EQUITY DAY APRIL 14, 2015



- It takes women until April 14, 2015 to earn what men got at the end of 2014.
- Among full-time, year-round workers, women are typically paid **78 percent** of what men are paid.
- The pay gap is **worse for women of color**.
- When you account for all factors known to affect pay, women are still paid almost **7 percent less** than men just one year after college — and the gap only grows from there.
