AAUW Greensboro's statement of support says in part, "Together with other collaborating partners, we enthusiastically endorse and offer our commitment to support Degree's Matter!'s application for an AAUW Community Action Grant to fund a project which will enable local women to take an introductory welding program to assess their interest in the field and to bridge the gender divide which keeps women from benefiting from lucrative careers......Once women have completed the introductory course, we look forward to supporting their efforts to enroll in the welding associate's degree program offered by Guilford Technical and Community College (GTCC)."
