Preview Highlights:

- North Carolina ranks 11th highest in infant mortality and 9th highest in stroke mortality among women — and it's even worse in rural counties.
- North Carolina's mortality rates for heart disease, stroke, diabetes, and breast cancer, among other diseases, have decreased since the 2013 report!

The Status of Women report features snapshots on health topics ranging from teen pregnancy and sexually transmitted disease to chronic disease and interpersonal violence.
