

8 area students achieved ASPIRE IT grants for a total of \$15,500 in 2020 - 2021

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AAUW Greensboro is the fiscal agent and program partner sponsoring oneday programs such as Triad Tech Savvy and Find Your STEM conference; semester long programs such as Code for Change and Codeista; summer camps such as IT IS FOR GIRLS. We have served approximately 100 middle school girls in 2020 - 2021.

AAUW Greensboro formed a successful partnership with TechGirlz in 2020 and has offered five 2.5 hour short virtual programs for over 100

students.
